EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Sangguniang Panlungsod enacted Ordinance No. 29, Series of 2021 authorizing the acceptance of 3,173 applications for new Motorized Tricycle Operators Permit (MTO). This is in accordance with the LPTRP and the Tricycle Route Plan. The purpose of such ordinance is to lessen, if not totally eradicate colorum tricycle operation and give these private tricycles opportunity to legally operate by grant of a franchise.

The City Franchising Office rendered a report on the two scheduled dates of application for acceptance of initial requirements conducted on February 23-27, 2022 and March 9-11, 2022. The data, per report submitted, showed that not all the opened slots were availed of due to a number of reasons, the most prevalent of them were that the Certificate of Registration were done outside the LTO Koronadal District and next to it is that there are old motorcycles that were only registered as tricycle in the year 2021 and 2022. With these reasons, the Chairperson of the Committee on Transportation recommended for the amendment of the Ordinance in order to allow the disqualified applicants to consequently qualify, notwithstanding the compliance to the other requirements provided in the previous Ordinance. Hence, this Ordinance:

ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 3, 5, 7, AND 8 OF ORDINANCE NO. 29, SERIES OF 2021, TO EXPAND THE COVERAGE ON RULES OF ENTRY, DOCUMENTARY REQUIREMENTS OF APPLICANTS FOR NEW MTO, AND REGISTRATION AS TRICYCLES-FOR-HIRE

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Koronadal, Province of South Cotabato, in session assembled, that:

Section 1. Section 3, paragraph 3 is hereby amended as follows:

"XXXXXX

However, no application for new MTOP shall be accepted unless the applicant is in possession of units with valid registration papers from Land Transportation Office (LTO), the subject tricycle unit/s applied for MTOP being registered as private motorcycle with sidecar, or private tricycle, not later than December 31, 2021. Those registered as tricycle, or motorcycle with sidecar, within the year 2022 shall also be allowed entry, provided, the motorcycle must have been bought and first registered not later than December 31, 2021. This requirement must be clearly established by the applicant by submitting a machine copy of their first registration and/or a certification from the LTO where the said motorcycle was first registered, the details of the motorcycle detailed therein. Further, the applicant must have satisfactorily complied with the other requirements as set forth in this Ordinance."

Section 2. Section 5 (b) is hereby amended as follows:

"b. Documentary Requirements

b.1 Initial Requirements:

i. Renewed Certificate of Registration (CR) of motorcycle ownership and Official Receipt (OR) for Payment of Registration duly registered with the Land Transportation Office LTO indicating that the same unit is registered not later than December 31, 2021 as private motorcycle with sidecar. For those registered as tricycle, or motorcycle with sidecar, within the year 2022, a machine copy of their first registration and/or a certification from the LTO where the said motorcycle was first registered, the details of the motorcycle detailed therein showing that said motorcycle was bought and first registered not later than December 31, 2021.

b.2 Documentary Requirements for the Issuance of MTOP:

iii. 2 copies -Certificate of Registration of motorcycle ownership and Official Receipt for Payment of Registration duly registered with Land Transportation Office

Section 3. Section 7, paragraph 3 is hereby amended, as follows:

“Xxxx After issuance of the Certificate of approval, the subject unit must be registered as tricycle-for-hire exclusively with the LTO Koronadal District, prior to the unit’s repainting.”

Section 4. Section 8 (a) is hereby amended as follows:

a. MOTORIZED TRICYCLE-FOR-HIRE

“Within three (3) months after the issuance of the MTOP, and after registration as tricycle-for-hire with the LTO Koronadal District xxxxxxxx”

Section 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE

If any provision/s of this Ordinance or a part hereof, is held invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of the law or the provisions not otherwise affected shall remain valid and subsisting.

Section 6. REPEALING CLAUSE


Any law, presidential decree or issuance, executive order, letter of instruction, administrative order, rule or regulation, ordinance contrary to or is inconsistent with the provision of this Ordinance is hereby repealed, modified or amended accordingly.

Section 7. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE


This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.
